This year, the classic movie "It's a Wonderful Life" turns 70 years old. Earn your wings with friends and family by sharing these fun facts about the holiday favorite:

- The film was based on the 1943 short story "The Greatest Gift" by Philip Van Doren Stern.
- Featuring Jimmy Stewart's return to acting after serving in World War II, the movie was the first starring role for Donna Reed.
- The elaborate set for Bedford Falls covered 4
 acres of a movie lot in Encino, Calif. It included
 75 buildings and a main street that was three
 city blocks long.
- For the film's winter scenes, the special effects crew came up with a groundbreaking way to make snow: They mixed the fire-extinguishing chemical Foamite with sugar, water and soap flakes, then pumped the mixture through a wind machine.
- The famous finale originally had the cast singing "Ode to Joy" rather than "Auld Lang Syne."
- A box office bomb in 1946, the movie only made back \$3.3 million of its \$3.7 million budget. It didn't become a beloved holiday tradition until it was repeatedly aired on TV in the 1970s and '80s.
- In 2006, the American Film Institute named "It's a Wonderful Life" the most inspiring film of all time.

The Rock of New York

Rockefeller Center is a vibrant and popular New York City landmark, created as a first-of-its-kind "city within a city." The 22-acre plaza was the brainchild of oil heir and philanthropist John D. Rockefeller Jr., who envisioned a modern commercial complex in the heart of midtown Manhattan. Built between 1931 and 1940, the project was personally financed by Rockefeller, a venture that helped restore the city's morale and employed thousands of workers during the Depression.

The original complex of 14 high-rises was the first in the world to feature business offices, retail shops, restaurants and entertainment in one development. The skyscrapers' heights and modern advances, such as high-speed elevators, indoor parking, an underground concourse, more than 100 pieces of public art, and art deco architecture, all symbolized progress to new frontiers.

Some of the attractions of today's 19 buildings include NBC network headquarters and studios; the Top of the Rock Observation Deck, which offers panoramic views of the city; and Radio City Music Hall, where the world-famous Rockettes perform.

On average, about 400,000 people visit Rockefeller Center every day, and the number can double during the holiday season, when they come to enjoy its iconic decorations, ice skating rink and shows.
