Wishing you a joyful and healthy July!



Keep Your Cool

When it's hot outside, stay cool inside. As the summer heat slowly retreats, don't slack on saving energy costs to cool your home. Here are a few tricks to reduce the effects the summer sun has on your energy bill: Green light. Make the green choice and switch your light bulbs to compact fluorescent bulbs. Compared to regular light bulbs, CFLs use 75 percent less energy. CFLs produce less heat and last up to 10 times longer than traditional lighting. Two degrees. For every 2 degrees your thermostat is raised, you can reduce your cooling costs by 3 percent. So, turn up your air conditioner a few notches, especially if you're not home.

Spin me right round. Put those ceiling and floor fans to use. Air circulation makes a room feel up to 3 degrees cooler.

Seal it. Replace old refrigerator door seals. Test to see if yours needs to be changed by closing the door on a dollar bill. If it pulls out without resistance, the seal needs to be replaced.
