### Understanding Medicare

Medicare has been around since 1965 and is health insurance for people aged 65 and older, those with certain disabilities, and people with End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD).

Original Medicare is run by the Federal Government and provides Part A and Part B coverage. Part A, also known as "hospital insurance" pays for services provided by an inpatient hospital, skilled nursing facility, and hospice. Part B, also known as "medical insurance", covers 80% of doctors' visits and outpatient care such as therapy and other medical expenses. You can also join a prescription drug plan under Medicare Part D.

Typically a person will not pay a monthly premium for Medicare Part A. However, most people will pay a standard monthly premium for Part B coverage.

Medicare Part C offers coverage provided by a Medicare Advantage Plan. Unlike original Medicare, these plans are run by private companies approved by Medicare and may offer extra coverage and prescription drugs at an extra cost. Therapy, for example, could be covered by a Medicare Advantage Plan if it is approved. These plans typically involve a co-payment to be paid by the beneficiary.

A Supplemental Insurance Plan, also known as a "Medigap" plan, covers some costs that Medicare Parts A and B don't. Medicare Part B typically pays 80% of medical costs such as therapy. A Supplemental Insurance Plan may pay for part of or the entire remaining 20%.
